According to Dr Julian De Silva, from the <u>Centre For Advanced Facial Cosmetic & Plastic Surgery in London</u>, Megan has spent around £8,000 on a nose job, £3,000 on cheek fillers, £6,000 on chin re-shaping and £3,500 on having her ears pinned back.

Not only this, but he states she spent £3,000 on lip fillers, £1,000 on skin treatments, £9,000 on veneers, £500 on boots and £6,000 on a breast enhancement – making the total cost around £40,000.

Dr Julian stated that would be "a fraction of what she will make through appearing on Love Island with all the work as a model she will get after the show is over."
