## 'Awkward' Robert Pattinson still shocked he won role of 'beautiful' Twilight lead

Robert Pattinson still can't believe he landed the starring role in Twilight, because he never thought he'd become a handsome leading man.

The Brit, who is now shooting the latest Batman drama, was recently named the "world's most handsome man" by facial plastic surgeon Dr. Julian De Silva, but he insists he doesn't understand the hype about his looks.
